










# NEW ORLEANS, LA

CURRENT STATUS AS OF APRIL 30, 2021

The City of New Orleans continues to meet all public health milestones and has vaccinated over 42% of the population with the COVID-19 vaccine. Therefore, the New Orleans Health Department is easing restrictions on certain activities. These restrictions will be effective as of April 30, 2021 at 6:00 A.M.
